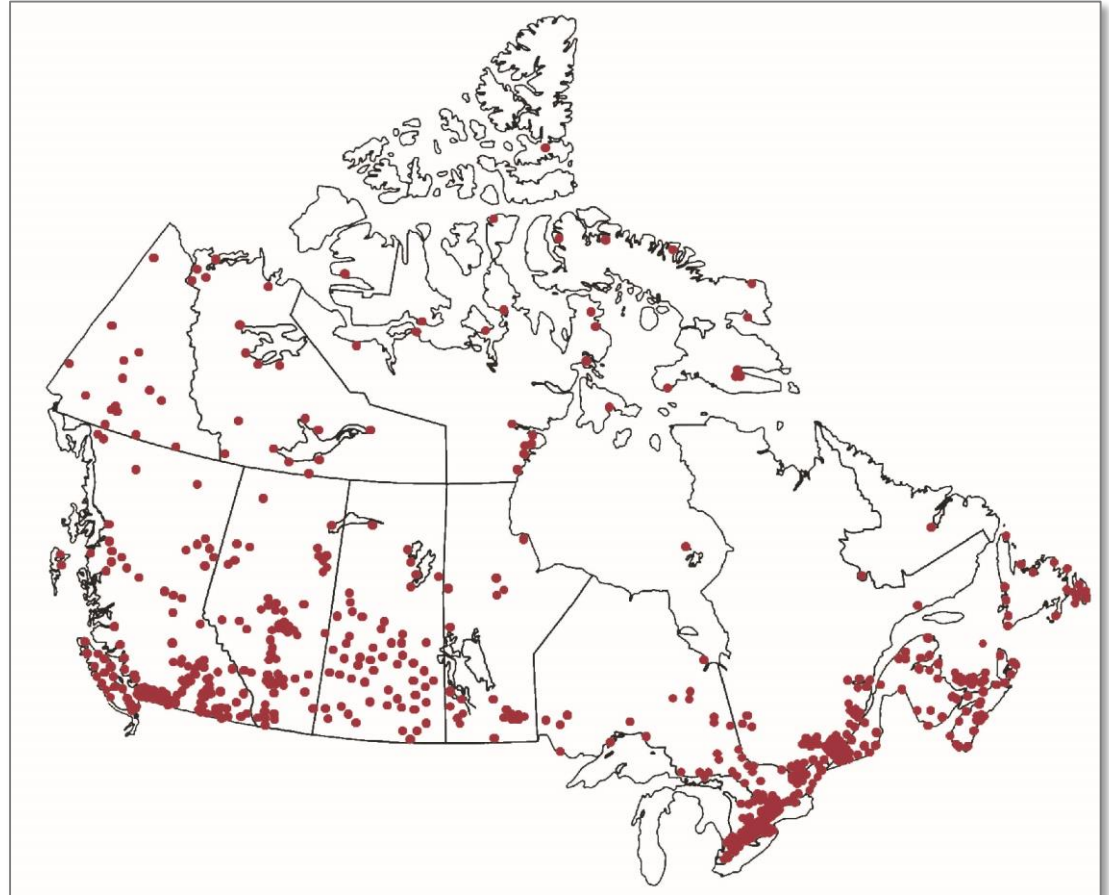

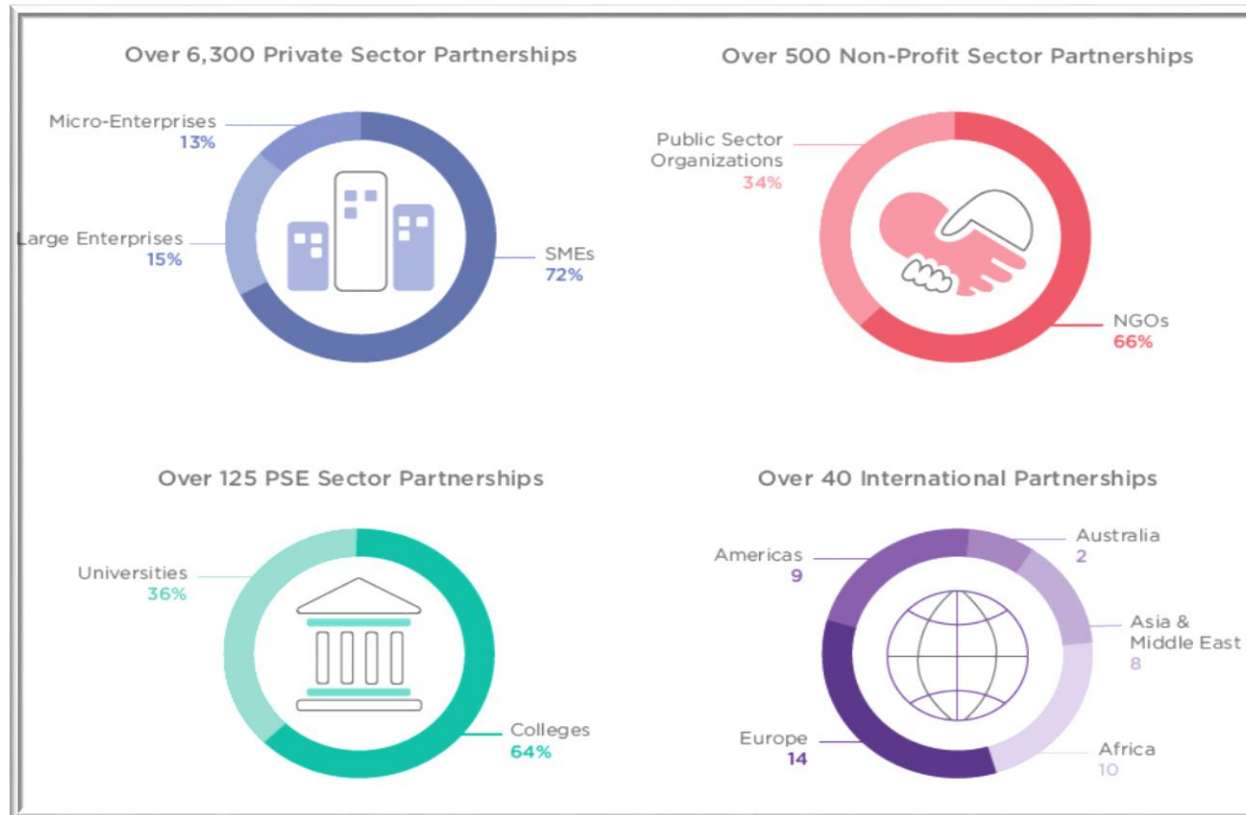

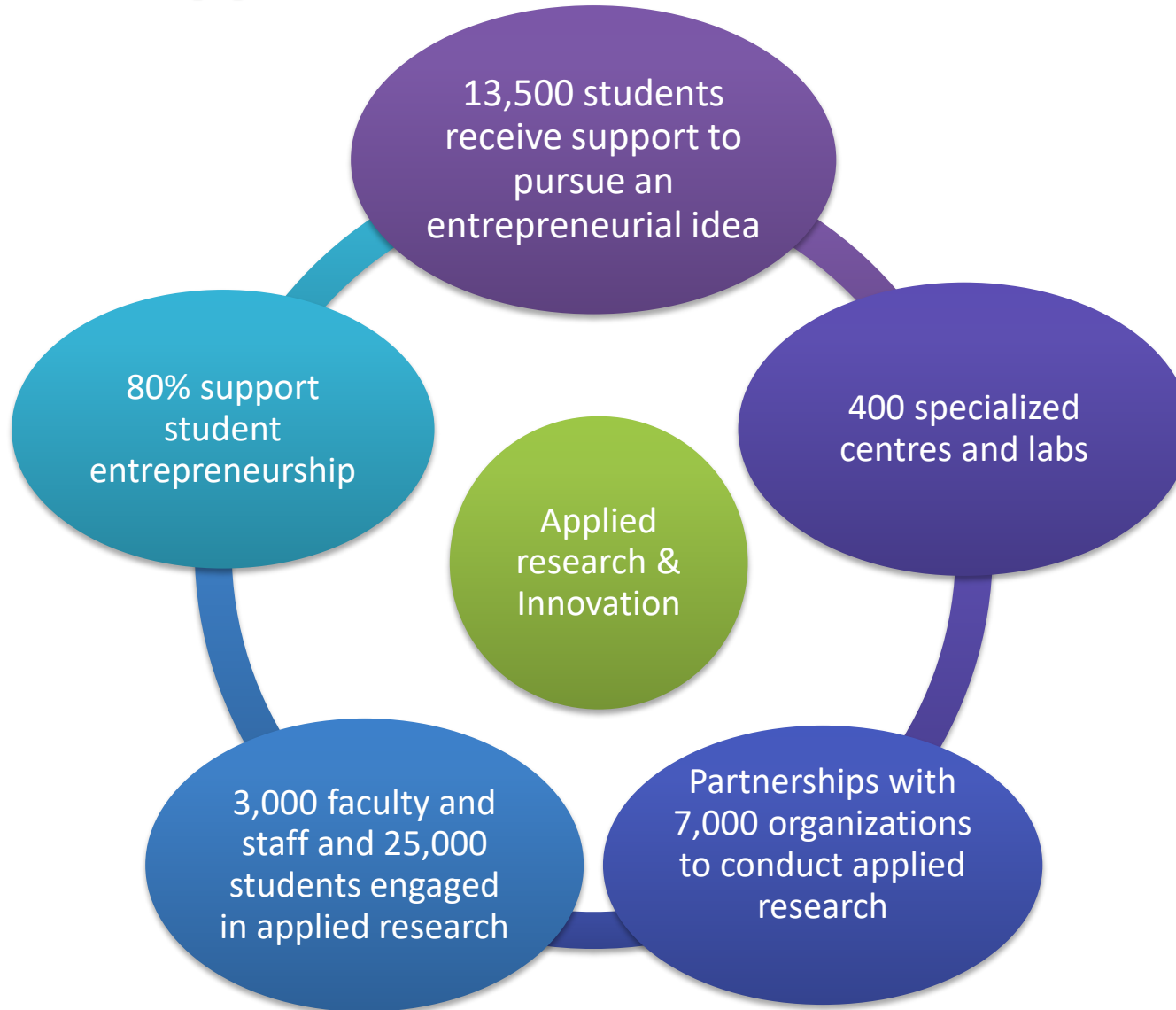
Partnerships – Facts and Figures



- 2010-2011 - The number of partnerships with SMEs increased by **23%** and the number of partnerships with large enterprises has increased by **51%**.
- Since 2010-2011, the largest growth occurred in partnerships with micro-entreprises (increase of **560%**) and the non-profit sector (increase **76%**).

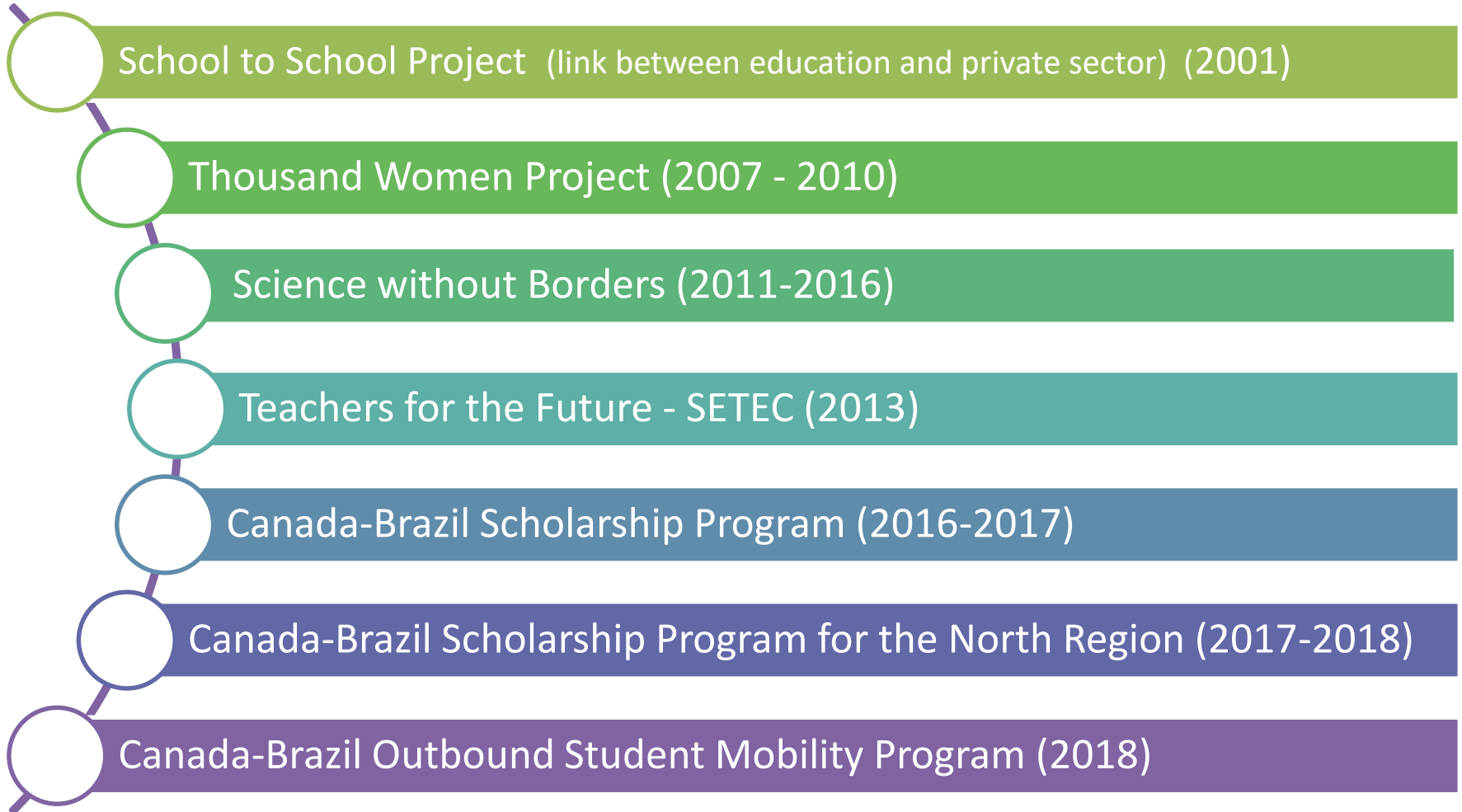

Development of Innovation centres in Federal Institutes (IFs)



Support for IF participation to SwB

- CICan assisted Brazil with the 1st public call of technical training of SwB.
- CICan had signed MoUs with CAPES, CNPq and SETEC.
- June 2013 – Promotional tour undertaken with Canadian colleges for the SwB program – More than 3,200 students from 38 different IFs from all regions of Brazil were met.
- Objective was to showcase Canada as a leader in technical and applied education.







Science without Borders (SwB)



Aimed at stimulating innovation and creating international partnerships



Students were placed at 36 colleges and institutes across Canada



Almost 890 students studied at Canadian colleges and institutes



Ninety-five percent (95%) studied in English and five percent (5%) in French

2016-2017 Canada-Brazil Scholarship Program

- Developed by CICan in collaboration with CONIF.
- Scholarship was entirely funded by CICan.
- Allowed 19 Brazilian IF students studying in a technology program (undergraduates) to improve their proficiency in English or French, complement their post-secondary training and complete an internship.
- 19 IF students from 16 different IFs studied at Canadian colleges and institutes for a period of 12 to 16 months.
- Broad range of studies: Business Administration, Graphic Design, Culinary Arts, Environment, Renewable Energy, Fashion, Information Technology, Video Game Design & Development, etc.



Canada-Brazil Scholarship Program for the North Region



Scholarship program developed in collaboration with CONIF and dedicated to students from the northern region of Brazil.



Program fully funded by CICan.



2 IF students from the northern region (Tocantins and Roraima) were selected.



Students started their 14-month programs (language training, post-secondary training & internship) in November 2017.




Canada-Brazil Outbound Student Mobility Program



Program developed to encourage Canadian student mobility to Brazil



Working in collaboration with Conif and FORINTER



Canadian students to go to Brazil for 2-month cultural international experience – May and June 2018



Bursaries of up to \$5,000 to offset some of the travel and living abroad costs.
